

Privacy Policy

Protecting your private information is our priority. This Statement of Privacy applies to the www.uschinahealthsummit.org and U.S.-China Health Summit and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to U.S.-China Health Summit include www.uschinahealthsummit.org, U.S.-China Health Summit, www.uschinahealthsummit.org and www.health-summit.org. The U.S.-China Health Summit website is a news and information site. By using the U.S.-China Health Summit website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

U.S.-China Health Summit may collect personally identifiable information, such as your name. U.S.-China Health Summit may also collect anonymous demographic information, which is not unique to you, such as your age, gender, household income, political affiliation, race and religion. We may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by U.S.-China Health Summit. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the U.S.-China Health Summit website.

U.S.-China Health Summit encourages you to review the privacy statements of websites you choose to link to from U.S.-China Health Summit so that you can understand how those websites collect, use and share your information. U.S.-China Health Summit is not responsible for the privacy statements or other content on websites outside of the U.S.-China Health Summit website.

Use of your Personal Information

U.S.-China Health Summit collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the services you have requested.

U.S.-China Health Summit may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from U.S.-China Health Summit and its affiliates. U.S.-China Health Summit may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

U.S.-China Health Summit does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

U.S.-China Health Summit may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is transferred to the third party. U.S.-China Health Summit may share data with trusted partners to help perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to

provide these services to U.S.-China Health Summit, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

U.S.-China Health Summit may keep track of the websites and pages our users visit within U.S.-China Health Summit, in order to determine what U.S.-China Health Summit services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within U.S.-China Health Summit to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

U.S.-China Health Summit will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on U.S.-China Health Summit or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of U.S.-China Health Summit; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of U.S.-China Health Summit, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The U.S.-China Health Summit website may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize U.S.-China Health Summit pages, or register with U.S.-China Health Summit site or services, a cookie helps U.S.-China Health Summit to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same U.S.-China Health Summit website, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the U.S.-China Health Summit features that you customized.
